

MusikTheater an der Wien im MuseumsQuartier

The Theater an der Wien is one of Vienna's most beautiful and historically significant theaters. Built in 1801 in the spirit of Mozart by his librettist Emanuel Schikaneder, it has seen many historic world premieres, including Beethoven's only opera Fidelio!

To coincide with the celebrations marking Mozart's 250th birthday, the Theater an der Wien was reopened in 2006 as "the new opera house" of the City of Vienna.

Raimund Theater

Named after the Austrian dramatist Ferdinand Raimund, the theater was built by an association of Viennese citizens and opened on 28 November 1893 with Raimund's play "Die gefesselte Phantasie".

The Theater-Center Forum has 3 auditoriums, divided over two floors - Hall I on the ground floor is designed in the classicist style, Hall II is decorated in Art Nouveau style and Hall III is decorated in retro style!

Almost 30,000 people visit around forty premieres and slightly more than 350 shows every season. Drama, comedy, crime thrillers, musicals, shows, cabaret, travesty, and special guest performances are all included in the schedule.
